

We stopped by!

As part of your enrollment in the Detroit Soil Lead Study led by EcoWorks, Earthworks Urban Farm, and Wayne State University, our team of scientists visited your property.

Here's what you need to know:

1. The sampling sites have a series of holes. Please **do not fill in the holes** – in most cases they will fill in naturally after a few rains.
2. Our scientists **may visit your home again** in late fall (2020) and again next summer (2021) depending on the results of your test. You will be notified in advance before we return.
3. You must remain in the program through next summer (2021) to be eligible for the **gift card drawing**.
4. You will find a yellow tent stake at the sampling sites. **DO NOT REMOVE THE YELLOW STAKE**. Removing the stake will make you no longer eligible for the drawing at the close of the study.
5. In the area immediately surrounding the tent stake, **do not modify the soil** until the close of the program in Summer 2021. It is ok to mow. However:
 - a. *Do not* add fertilizer, pesticides, or herbicides
 - b. *Do not* add compost
 - c. *Do not* plant new plants
 - d. *Do not* dig or till in the immediate area.

If you have to perform any of these tasks, please notify us at the contact information below and we will remove you from the study and the gift card drawing.

6. You will receive all results from all tests performed on your soil. These tests typically cost \$25+ and your results will be provided at **no cost to you**. Results will be provided to the email address you provided or via mail if we don't have an email address on file. All results will be *kept strictly confidential*.
